6. What happens as we yield ourselves up to Christ?
  
7. What do you think of the final statement? As I give myself wholly to Christ, I find the power to take Him wholly for myself; and as I lose myself and all I have for Him, He takes me wholly for Himself and gives Himself wholly to me.
